Dr. McClure said the degree audits for Psychology are often incorrect and correcting them has become time consuming. Assistant Dean Martinez will reach out to the Registrar's office for an updated list of attributes. Dr. Phelan said she had a similar issue and worked with Susan Bickel in the Registrar's office.

3. Advising

- The Dean's office is drafting a faculty advising handbook.
- When the draft is complete it will be shared with department chairs for comments and edits.
- Once approved it will be posted on the faculty portal (printed copies will be available.)

4. **Internships** the Dean reminded Chairs:

- To have their department internship coordinator to work with Kim Nickolenko to ensure students have internship opportunities.
- Faculty need to encourage students to attend the career night events.

The Dean thanked the Council for their work on assessment; Dr. Dallavalle is submitting the report to NECHE that shows 91% compliance.

Program Review Process the Dean thanked Dr. Petrino for assisting departments with their review process. Program reviews are important for department assessment and strategic planning. External reviewers bring perspective for resources and curricular changes. Moving forward Dr. Lacy will assist programs through the review process.
