Course Sequence: Scaffolding Learning & Writing

Questions to Consider:

- Column 1: How will your **learning objectives** be **sequenced** (i.e. do certain ones need to come before others)? Do certain learning objectives repeat in multiple weeks (i.e. as students work on a large assignment or tackle difficult concepts)?
- Column 2: What original source **material** will support students to develop foundational knowledge with respect to each objective?
- Column 3: What writing to learn activities will deepen students' engagement with and learning of course content (learning objectives)?
- <u>Column 4</u>: **WID** Courses: Identify the **strategies** you will use to **scaffold** students' developing abilities as writers in the discipline. What opportunities will they have to practice and receive feedback on the writing skills required in the final assessment?
